

Subject: CNR Undergraduate Researcher of the Year Selection

The following is a description of the procedures for selecting the CNR Undergraduate Researcher of the Year.

Any students in CNR engaged in undergraduate research are eligible. CNR defines undergraduate research in its broadest sense; it is up to students and nominating faculty supervisors to clarify any ambiguity.

Nominations may be made by any faculty member or graduate student in the college. Nominations may be brief but should be sufficiently complete to allow the selection committee to judge the merit of the student's efforts.

The Undergraduate Scholarship Committee will review all nominations. Nominations and any support materials need to be turned in to the Dean's Office by February 13.
