

OUTSTANDING SENIOR AWARDS

Departmental Outstanding Seniors:

Each department selects its outstanding senior based on:

1. scholastic achievement,
2. college/university/community involvement, and
3. professional commitment to the natural resources field.

This will not necessarily be the student in your department with the highest GPA, but instead the well-rounded student who has excelled academically while also participating in service and professional activities. S/he will typically be well-known amongst CNR faculty and students.

CNR Outstanding Senior:

From the list of (3) students selected as departmental outstanding seniors, the CNR Scholarship Committee selects the CNR Outstanding Senior. Selection will be based on the criteria listed above (traditionally, scholastic achievement is the primary criterion if the extracurricular records are similar).

Announcement of Awards: Departmental outstanding seniors are announced in late February and will be invited to the CNR awards banquet. The recipient of the CNR Outstanding Senior award is kept confidential until announced at the awards banquet.
