

The Seely-Hinckley Scholarship

These scholarships are awarded each year by the Graduate School to outstanding graduate students who face serious financial difficulties in attending USU. The students must be full time but there are no other requirements.

The Seeley-Hinckley Scholarship pays instate tuition for 9 credits for one year (two semesters). It also pays for student fees.

College deans are responsible for nominating candidates for the following school year by approximately April 1. The scholarship is paid through the financial aid office and number of scholarships is dependent on availability of funds.
